The Publication Scheme for New College, written in compliance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000, can be accessed by clicking on the link above. It follows a common pattern adopted by a number of Oxford Colleges.

The Head of House is responsible for maintaining the scheme on behalf of the College, and the scheme may be reviewed from time to time.

The purpose of the scheme is to give a clear indication of which College publications are routinely accessible, so that the public can be informed as far as is reasonably possible of the purpose and nature of College activities, and to assist in developing a greater culture of openness in general. Through this scheme the College endeavours to be as transparent as possible about its activities while at the same time recognising that
