

Suspension of studies (voluntary)

Voluntary suspension of studies is a request from a student to suspend on medical or personal grounds. The procedure is outlined below.

Suspension of studies (non-voluntary)

5. Once the Committee agrees the request, the formal paperwork will be processed and the student will receive a letter from the Senior Tutor confirming the details.

During suspension

You will receive a letter from the Senior Tutor when your suspension is formalised.

You will be expected to leave College as soon as is practicable and you will also receive a letter from the Dean confirming that during the period of your suspension there is no access to college facilities except with explicit permission, to be sought from him for individual events. Such permission is rarely not granted and if it is denied, a reason will be given. You retain access to your university email account, online university resources, university libraries and the university counselling service.
