

The manors of Alton Barnes with Shaw and Alton Priors, now the civil parish of Alton, are in the Vale of Pewsey on the Marlborough Downs in Wiltshire.¹ They include the highest point in the

A grant of these properties to Winchester does not appear to have happened at this date, but Wykeham seems to be preparing the ground more for such a development with maybe either of his prospective projects in 1375. On 18 June, in his palace at Southwark, he secured separate quitclaims from John [Frampton], grandson of Walter, and the abovementioned John K engrove of their rights in Alton Barnes and its advowson. These were affirmed shortly afterwards, on 25 June and 1 July respectively, by final concords in the king's court. For each of these Wykeham pays 200 marks (£133 6
